

Yeshiva University Scholarship Program for Grandchildren of Long-term Members of the Faculty and Staff

The Board of Trustees Executive Committee approved the establishment of a Scholarship Program, effective with the fall of 2001 semester, for the grandchildren of long-term members of the faculty and administration. This scholarship program was established to recognize the achievements of long-term members of the staff and to make it possible for their grandchildren to attend, without financial hardship, the institution that they helped to build over the last quarter of a century. The program will also encourage qualified students to enroll in the University, while it provides an incentive for members of the faculty and administration to become long-term staff members, so that their grandchildren can qualify for the program.

Basic Terms of the Program:

To be eligible, the student must be a grandchild of an active or retired member of the faculty or administration, who has served Yeshiva University on a full-time basis for no less than 25 consecutive years.
