The meeting was opened with the provost's report. The provost discussed the statement which will allow students to interact with Israeli students in dedicated space at YU. This is facilitated by donation for that purpose.

The court members followed with question regarding the academic nature of the student credits will be evaluated.

The provost distributed a fact book and a policy manual required by the state. Dr. Botan said that Middle States now visit campuses once every seven years. The evaluation is data driven and focuses on specifics.
