Prior to each registration each student meets with the director, who evaluates the skills and interests of the student and then pairs the student with the teachers who might be the best fit for that student. Class sizes are kept small and intimate. Teachers make themselves available to serve as advisers on an ongoing basis. Most teachers share their home phone numbers and cell phone numbers with their students. Teachers treat their students with respect, concern, and regard. Many Yeshiva faculty members live on campus and open their homes on a regular basis to host the students in the program. The regular off- campus weekend retreats also provide many opportunities for students to learn from their teachers and friends in a relaxed and comfortable atmosphere.
